PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE

CALL TO ORDER: Mayor Pro Tem Trbojevich called the public hearing to order at 6:02 p.m.

ROLL CALL: Members present were Deborah Trbojevich, Bob Lawson & Nancilyn Meyer. Bob Stein attended virtually via TEAMS and Trevor Guyer was absent. Staff present were John Dimich, Jestine Casey & Rick Rogich. Mike Finckbone attended remotely via TEAMS. Others present were Steve Hurd, Chuck Schafer, Paula Schafer, Darrell Zuehlke, Charlotte Zuehlke, Molly Randall & Bob Tok.

DISCUSSION: Trbojevich opened the floor to questions and comments. Many residents in attendance voiced their objections to vacating the portion of 4th Street by Bob Tok's property stating the road is utilized and should stay open. Tok agreed and advised that there was a misunderstanding as he doesn't want to shut down the street and only wants to narrow the portion by his property from 66 feet to 33 feet. Trbojevich agreed that the road should stay open & asked Attorney Dimich how to proceed with narrowing the street. Dimich advised that the City Engineer needs to survey the area and provide a description. Meyer questioned who would pay for the engineering costs as the city cannot afford to take on this project this year. Tok stated he would not agree to pay for costs associated with narrowing the street. Council discussed that the road will remain as-is for now and no action will be taken at this time.
